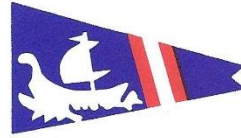

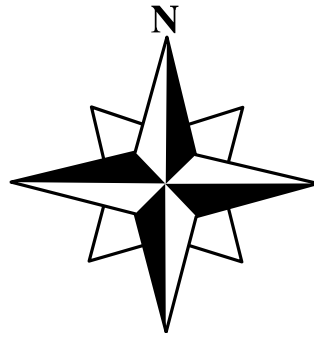
We will have plenty of moorage and power available.

Course Description-----Poulsbo Yacht Club Liberty Bay Challenge

General Information: This contest will be run in the waters of Puget Sound, Port Orchard / Port Madison, Liberty Bay and Agate Pass.

START to CP-1

Leg 1 **BEGIN THIS CONTEST ON RUNNING START at SLOW SPEED:**

Proceed on Course 105°-T from the **START LOCATION**, a Private Dock End, located at 47 42.335° N / 122 37.788° W, Stbd, extending on a bearing of 358°-T at 100 yds;

Leg 2 Continue to the Easterly Dock extension of the Keyport Marina Main Dock, located at 47 42.290° N / 122 37.435° W, Stbd, extending on a bearing of 359°-T, at 100 yds;

Leg 3 Continue to the extension of the NW corner of the White Bldg ("NO WAKE") on the west end of the Keyport Naval Dock, located at 47 42.330° N / 122 37.084° W, Stbd, extending on a bearing of 027°-T, between 125 & 150 yds;

Leg 4 Turn Stbd and continue to the extension of the NE corner of the Keyport Naval Building located at 47 42.023° N / 122 36.866° W, Stbd, extending on a bearing of 090°-T, between 225 & 275 yds;

Leg 5 **BEGIN CRUISE SPEED** and continue directly to **CP-1, an extension of a Fence / Rock Wall End** located at 47 41.455° N / 122 37.093° W, to Stbd, extending on a bearing of 090°-T, between 250 & 300 yds.

CP-1 to CP-2

Leg 6 Proceed on Course 142°-T until on a range of Bolin Pt and the East End of the Agate Pass Bridge long to Port;

Leg 7 Continue directly to an extension of the Brownsville Marina N. Dock End located at 47 39.150° N / 122 36.749° W, Stbd, extending on a bearing of 094°-T, at 300 yds;

Leg 8 Thence Begin TR-1 on Course 077°-T for .35 nautical miles;

Leg 9 Proceed to **CP-2, the Battle Point Lt Abeam** (47 39.791° N / 122 35.616° W), Stbd, between 250 & 300 yds.

CP- 2 to CP-3

Leg 10 Proceed directly, **without course deviation**, to an extension of the south side of a House (SW Corner), located at 47 41.861° / 122 33.839° W, Stbd, extending on a bearing of 281°-T, within 325 yds;

Leg 11 Continue to the Agate Pass Buoy R-4 Abeam (47 42.529° N / 122 34.187° W), to Port, between 175 & 200 yds;

Leg 12 Thence Continue to **CP-3, the South Face of the Agate Pass Bridge**.

CP-3 to CP-4

Leg 13 Proceed to the Agate Pass Light R-2 (47 43.315° N / 122 33.373° W), abeam to Port 100 yds;

Leg 14 Proceed on Course 048°-T until on an extension of the Center of the Suquamish Pier Ramp located at 47 43.778' N / 122 32.957' W, Port, , extending on a bearing of 090°-T, at 600 yds;

Leg 15 Thence commence a 180 degree turn to port with a radius of 100 yards. Call the mark when on a heading of 222°-T;

Leg 16 Continue to the Agate Pass Light R-2 (47' 43.315" N / 122' 33.373" W), abeam Stbd between 25 to 50 yds;

Leg 17 Thence **Continue to CP-4, the Agate Pass Buoy R-4 (47 42.529' N / 122 34.187' W), abeam Stbd at 50 yds.**

CP- 4 to CP-5

Leg 18 **Proceed from the Agate Pass Buoy R-4 at SLOW SPEED** to leave the Fish Pens to Port, within 125 yds;

Leg 19 Thence continue to the Agate Pass Lt R-6 (47 41.789' N / 122 34.553' W), Abeam, Stbd, at 150 yds;

Leg 20 **RESUME CRUISE SPEED and begin TR-2**, on Course 220°-T for .77 nautical miles;

Leg 21 Continue on Course 287°-T until on an extension of the Fence / Rock Wall End (aka CP-1) located at 47 41.455' N / 122 37.093' W, Port, long;

Leg 22 **Continue on Course 350°-T to CP-5, the extension of the SE corner of the Keyport Naval Building** located at 47 41.981' N / 122 36.858'W, Port, extending on a bearing of 090 °-T, between 450 & 500 yds.

CP- 5 to CP-6

Leg 23 **PROCEED AT SLOW SPEED,** to the extension of the NW corner of the White Bldg ("NO WAKE") on the west end of the Keyport Naval Dock located at 47 42.330' N / 122 37.084' W, Port, extending on a bearing of 027°-T between 300 & 350 yds;

Leg 24 Continue to the Lemolo Lt "2" (47 42.443' N / 122 37.623' W), Stbd, between 100 & 125 yds;

Leg 25 Continue to the extension of a Private Dock End located at 47 42.603' N / 122 38.117' W, Port, extending on a bearing of 090 °-T between 300 & 350 yds;

Leg 26 Continue to the extension of a Private Dock End located at 47 42.822' N / 122 37.734' W, Stbd, extending on a bearing of 271°-T between 250 & 300 yds;

Leg 27 **Continue directly to the Finish, CP-6, an extension of the Southeasterly Dock End of the Liberty Bay Marina** located at (47 43.356' N / 122 38.471' W), Stbd, extending on a bearing of 218°-T, Stbd, between 100 & 200 yds.

1. Extensions of docks, piers and the Fence / Rock Wall locations are provided from the water end of the structure.
2. All building extensions are located from the closest corner of the structure to the course turn point. This will insure accurate distances off the structure and clear viewing of the extension prior to calling the mark.

3. Pt. Bolin / Agate Pass Bridge East End Range: Although this range is long it is very visible and an easy mark to call.

**THE AGATE PASS FISH PENS ARE CONTAINED WITHIN THE FOLLOWING
COORDINANCE:**

SE CORNER---47 42.184' N / 122 34.498' W NE CORNER---47 42.226' N / 122

34.467' W

SW CORNER---47 42.198' N / 122 34.534' W NW CORNER---47 42.242' N / 122

34.507' W

Fender up and proceed to your PYC moorage. GOOD LUCK TO ALL!!!
