Stimson 2018 Poker Rules

- 1. Each observer is eligible for one entry of 5 cards
- 2. Each competing vessel is eligible for one entry of 5 cards
 - a. Contestant/Navigator must fight amongst themselves if they choose not to act as a team submission of one entry (we know your names...)
- 3. There shall not be more than number of vessels competing times two for total entries overall
- 4. There are no wild cards or jokers
- 5. One card will be provided for crossing the starting line and one for each checkpoint completed (up to five total cards)
- 6. A single bonus card will be provided for each checkpoint within +/- 5 seconds of error
- A single bonus card will be provided for finishing within +/- 60 seconds of predicted finish time
 - a. Calculated as predicted log finish time vs actual finish time
- 8. Cards will be drawn at time of log turn-in post rally
- 9. No duplicate cards may exist in a hand
 - a. If a card drawn already exists in hand, you must re-draw a card
 - b. If a participant attempts to trade cards, the poker committee did not see it...but there still cannot be any duplicates within a hand
- 10. Winning hand is determined using standard 5 card poker hand rankings
 - a. Multiple card decks will be in use
 - b. Any disputes of winning hand will be judged by the audience via loudest cheering
 - i. Moderator may accept bribes for any tie-breaking needs
 - ii. Outside of a small prize, you are really only competing for bragging rights at this point
 - iii. Any sore losers of tie-breaker may be required to cleanup clubhouse before leaving event
 - iv. If you are still actually reading these rules, there may be another bonus card provided at completed log turn-in moderator does accept bribes
- 11. To win, you must be present for the awards
- 12. There is only one award to be won, and bragging rights, sorry no big trophy or plaque.
